HUMBER RIVER TRAIL / EMERY CREEK BIKE TRAIL

PLUNKETT PARK

If you're looking for a unique outdoor experience, right in your neighbourhood, Plunkett Park has plenty to offer. With facilities such as a playground, a picnic courts, this space makes for a great time in both rain and shine.

GRACEDALE PARK

Spanning a rolling 3.2 hectares, it's arguably better named as a recreation centre than a park. ROWNTREE MILLS PARK

Named in honour of neighbourhood pioneer, Joseph Rowntree, who had built mills in the area in 1843. Today the 92 hectares offer plenty of open space for the community to enjoy sun and fresh air.

VINCENZO SCIDA WALKWAY

Luxor Homes is proud to name the connecting walkway in the Homes of St. Gaspar in memory of Vincenzo Scida. Vincenzo was a pillar in the community as a member of many associations, including North Islington Seniors as president. He was also part of

Associazione Nazionale Carabinieri di Toronto.

Emery Village Business Improvement Area

The Emery Village BIA was formed in 2003 and is Canada's largest Business Improvement Area with over 3,200 commercial, industrial and retail establishments employing approximately 25,000 people. It is also one of the City of Toronto's largest designated Employment Zones.


The BIA's mandate is to initiate and oversee community improvements such as beautifying the streetscape, creating public spaces with sustainable, inviting and safe environments, instilling a sense of community and civic pride in the neighbourhood, and celebrating the rich cultural history of Emery Village. Emery Village has completed 3 streetscape improvement projects in the immediate vicinity of St. Gaspars' neighbourhood including upgraded LED pedestrian lights, planters, hanging flower baskets, garden features, benches, coloured pavers, banners, and trees with seasonal lighting. These features enhance the pedestrian and shopping experience as part of the revitalization of the area.

In the summer months the BIA sponsors free Movie-In-The-Park nights. Kids and families love taking in the featured movies and enjoy refreshments under a canopy of the night sky. Past events have included Street Festivals, Christmas toy drives and visits from Santa. Not forgetting the grown-ups, the BIA organizes and promotes meetings, open houses and seminars on topics of importance to neighbours and businesses. If you miss any of this, the Emery Village Voice newspaper keeps you up to date on what's happening.

As part of a network of some 80 Business Improvement Areas throughout Toronto, Emery Village BIA's programs and plans are there to promote and maintain the sustainability of our local businesses to help them provide services, products and employment for our residential neighbourhoods. While each BIA is unique in promoting their local heritage, culture and neighbourhood distinctiveness, collectively we are also a strong voice for our communities and businesses.

YOU'RE A NATURAL

6 vegetable gardening tips every new food gardener needs to know



LET THERE BE LIGHT

(tomatoes, cucumbers, squash, and peppers, for example) need sun, and a lot of it. Ideally, some edibles; mainly leafy crops and herbs.

SOIL IS EVERYTHING

Healthy, rich soil is the key to a successful and productive vegetable garden, so don't skip this step! A soil test will give you an idea of your existing soil fertility and pH, and offer suggestions of what types of fertilizers or amendments will get your plot up to par. In my own garden, I rely on homemade compost, organic well-composted animal manures, and organic fertilizers like kelp meal and alfalfa meal.



KEEP IT SMALL

Most veggies, especially those that bear fruit A vegetable garden can be low-maintenance, but it's not no-maintenance. Therefore, do yourself a favor and stick to a small plot you want a site with at least 8 hours of direct for the first year or two. A 4 by 8 foot bed sun per day. In less light, you can still grow is ideal for a starter veggie garden and will give you enough space to grow a handful of crops (see the next point). If you wish to start even smaller, try planting container-friendly veggies and herbs in pots or window-boxes on a sunny deck.

PICK YOUR PLANTS

With your first veggie garden, it's very tempting to want to grow everything! But, for your own sake, I'd suggest you pick 4 to 5 types of vegetables and grow them well. Trying to cram too much in a compact space is asking for trouble and you'll end up with a smaller, not larger harvest. However, you can boost yield by succession planting. When your initial crops have been harvested, follow up with a second sowing. For example, follow spring lettuce with summer beans. Succession planting allows you to stretch your harvest season for the longest possible time.

BRING ON THE BLOOMS

A vegetable garden can be low-maintenance, but it's not no-maintenance. Therefore, do yourself a favor and stick to a small plot for the first year or two. A 4 by 8 foot bed is ideal for a starter veggie garden and will give you enough space to grow a handful of crops (see the next point). If you wish to start even smaller, try planting container-friendly veggies and herbs in pots or window-boxes on a sunny deck.

WATER, WEED & FEED

This might seem to be one of the most obvious vegetable gardening tips, but new veggie gardeners may not know when or how much to water. Newly seeded beds will need frequent watering, but most established crops can get by on one to two inches of water per week. To conserve water and reduce the need to irrigate, mulch your soil with several inches of straw or shredded leaves. Side benefit: the mulch will also suppress weeds! As for feeding, quick growing crops like radishes and lettuce won't need supplemental fertilizers if grown in in fertile soil. Long-term veggies like tomatoes, winter squash, and eggplants, however, will appreciate a boost several times over the growing season. Give them an occasional dose of a water soluble organic food to support growth and encourage the biggest







Your fork gliding through a cloud of featherlight zabaglione mixed with maxarpone and whipped cream, a bit of cocoa settling on the tines, and then through Italian ladylingers softened by their dip in liqueur spiked expresso. This tiramism is a dream of a dessert not least because its so easy to put together.

YIELD Makes 8 to 10 servings **ACTIVE TIME** 30 min TOTAL TIME 7 hr

INGREDIENTS

2 cups boiling-hot water

3 tablespoons instant-espresso powder 1/2 cup plus 1 tablespoon sugar, divided

3 tablespoons Tia Maria (coffee liqueur)

4 large egg yolks

1 cup chilled heavy cream

36 savoiardi (crisp Italian ladyfingers;

from two 7-ounce packages) Unsweetened cocoa powder for dusting

1/3 cup dry Marsala 1 pound mascarpone (2 1/2 cups)

PREPARATION

Stir together water, espresso powder, 1 tablespoon sugar, and Tia Maria in a shallow bowl until sugar has dissolved, then cool.

Beat egg yolks, Marsala, and remaining 1/2 cup sugar in a metal bowl set over a saucepan of barely simmering water using a whisk or handheld electric mixer until tripled in volume, 5 to 8 minutes. Remove bowl from heat. Beat in mascarpone until just combined. Beat cream in a large bowl until it holds stiff peaks. Fold mascarpone mixture into whipped cream gently but thoroughly.

Dipping both sides of each ladyfinger into coffee mixture, line bottom of a 13- by 9- by 3-inch baking pan with 18 ladyfingers in 3 rows, trimming edges to fit if necessary. Spread half of mascarpone filling on top. Dip remaining 18 ladyfingers in coffee and arrange over filling in pan.

Spread remaining mascarpone filling on top and dust with cocoa. Chill, covered, at least 6 hours. Let tiramisu stand at room temperature 30 minutes before serving, then dust with more cocoa.

NOTE

You can substitute 2 cups freshly brewed espresso for the water and instant-espresso powder. Tiramisu can be chilled up to 2 days.
